Self-Help Forum

On March 26, 2007 the SHRC hosted a self-help forum called "Grouping for Change". This was done to bring together self-helpers and professionals who work with self-help, in an effort to build a larger community.

Over 70 people attended this meeting where they learned about self-help models from Germany and Australia.

Participants also divided into four groups to discuss the issues that many self-help and support groups share in common: promotion, insurance, space rental and funding.

Many issues and ideas were raised and shared. Some participants expressed interest in forming a working group to continue to explore these issues. The SHRC will continue to support the efforts of the working group in the fall of this year.

Helen Nolan 1943-2007

On Monday, May 14 our volunteer, Helen passed away suddenly. The following biography is from her memorial service.

Helen Thundercloud ka-nah-kwad, a medicine woman and "catcher" of babies, she was strongly rooted in her traditions and had absolute respect for Aboriginal ways of knowing, learning, and healing. Helen was presented with a pipe by a Circle of Elders in AB. in 2002 and has been a firekeeper since 2000.

Throughout her career as a teacher and counselor, Helen had maintained a focus on healing work with First Nations people. "Kitchi Nendum," is a program of her own design that specifically addresses identity issues and stresses the importance of reclamation of our history, culture and traditions.

Helen was an established educator and trainer specializing in the provision of client-specific seminars and workshops on various topics including Communications, Cultural Sensitization, Conflict Management and Alternative Dispute Resolution. Helen's experience also included teaching Communications at Community Colleges in Manitoba and North Western Ontario.

As an adult educator, Helen was committed to First Nation's efforts to achieve self-determination; she proudly lists the establishment of Aboriginal schools in Winnipeg as one of her achievements.
